CAMP FEES:

All unpaid fees are due before check-in at camp. If you registered online, your remaining funds will be auto-drafted 3 days before camp. Any cancellations must be made at least 1 week prior to camp to receive a refund. Any cancellations after this time will be charged the full non-refundable deposit (\$150). Cancellations must email southwestregioncamps@fca.org.

- **Meal Card/Room Key:** lost keys will cost the camper \$50 and lost meal cards will cost \$15. This is a university policy and charge that the dorm will collect at check-out on Thursday if not returned.
- **Parking Pass:** If a student is planning to drive themselves and park a vehicle for the duration of camp, you must notify the Lubbock FCA Office (806) 740-8322 by June 19, 2017. Detailed directions for obtaining parking pass will be given at that time. There will be a \$7 per day fee for parking required by TTU.

WHAT TO BRING:

Modest clothing is required at all times during camp. Game equipment such as balls will be provided, but you will need to bring plenty of athletic clothes/sports attire and personal equipment for your selected sport (shoes/cleats, knee pads, gloves, etc.), and a daily change of clothes for evening sessions. Additionally, make sure to bring:

- Journal and Pen
- Personal Toiletries & Towel
- Bedding (sleeping bag or sheets/blanket & pillow)
- Extra spending money for camp store
- You may bring snacks & water for your room
- Backpack, sunscreen, water bottle
- Alarm clock

Please do NOT bring:

- Jewelry or other expensive items
- iPods, electronic games, TVs or radios
- NO pets of any kind.
- NO ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREARMS OR WEAPONS ARE ALLOWED AT ANYTIME ON CAMPUS.

CELL PHONES:

Cell phones **are allowed**, but will be collected periodically throughout the week to eliminate distractions during meetings.

CHECKING IN:

- Camp officially starts at 1:15pm with meetings in the dorms to meet your Huddle Leader.
- Allow plenty of time in case of long lines.
- Eat lunch before checking in. First camp meal will be dinner Monday at 5:30pm.

Directions:

Stangel/Murdough is located near the center of campus. FCA signs will be clearly visible on campus pointing you to the registration area.

- If coming from West, on 62/82 E (Marsha Sharp FWY), Exit 19th St. Turn Left/North on Flint Ave. Turn Right on Main St, then right into parking lot.
- If coming from East, on 62/82 E (Marsha Sharp FWY), Exit on University St. Go South, turn Right/East on 19th St. Turn Right/North on Flint Ave. Turn Right on Main St, then right into parking lot.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS:

The following items are needed to complete your registration at check in:

- FCA Student Permission Waiver Form
- Copy of Insurance Card
- Remaining Balance (if any)

**If you enrolled online, all of these items will have been completed!*

DEPARTURE:

- Camp ends at **2:00pm, Thursday, 6/29/16.**
- Check-out will be at Stangel/Murdough (Same as check-in).
- The final camp meal will be lunch on Thursday, June 29th.

INSURANCE:

FCA will only provide secondary insurance coverage for the camper during the stay at camp. In case of injury or illness, campers will need to provide a proof of insurance coverage at the time of treatment. A photocopy of your insurance card will be sufficient. Campers not covered by family insurance will be cared for.

MEDICINE:

All medicines (including over the counter pain relief like Tylenol etc.) must be turned in to the Camp Nurse/Athletic Trainers upon check-in and will be administered as needed. Refrigeration will be available as needed.

FCA SWAG:

All campers will receive a camp t-shirt, lanyard, nametag and Bible at check-in. If you would like to purchase anything extra – we will have all the swag you could ever dream of in the camp store! Make sure to bring some extra cash if you want to shop FCA!

- *Can I come late or leave early?* – Yes, as long as a parent/guardian notifies us.
